Jerry Zucker Middle School has joined 25 other schools in the Charleston County School District that are participating in the At-Risk Afterschool Care Program (ARACP), also known as the Supper Program. This program enables the participating schools to provide free meals to students who stay after school for educational or enrichment activities. Providing nutritious meals during an afterschool program gives students a nutritional boost along with a safe and nurturing environment with opportunities for learning and growing. The Supper Program, which was developed by the USDA, is coordinated at the district level by Ms. Angela McLaughlin, a Food Service Supervisor in CCSD's Nutrition and Food Service Department. Assistant Principal Mr. Anthony J. Dixon coordinates the program at Zucker Middle. According to Ms. McLaughlin, there will be 35 schools in the district participating in the program by October 1st of this year.
